Council Action Report (May 13, 2018)

- Minutes from the April 8, 2018 Council meeting were unanimously approved as amended. The Minutes were amended to reflect an ending balance of \$43,410.37 on the March Treasurer's Report. The error didn't show salaries deducted from the Report.
- Pastor requested vacation July 9-15, 2018. A motion was made to approved Pastor's vacation. The motion was seconded, and unanimously approved.

Quilters of Grace

In November, the quilters sent 100 quilts to Lutheran World Relief in New Windsor, Maryland. Since then, the quilts have been distributed to countries around the world. Puerto Rico, Lebanon, Tanzania, Angola and India to name a few.

Once the quilts arrived in Maryland, they were repackaged and readied for shipment to other countries in need. In other countries, the quilts must clear customs and are transferred to storage until they can be sorted according to local needs. The time and care put into the making and packaging of the quilts ensures that they arrive in good condition and in a manner that promotes dignity of the recipients.

The quilters currently have about 50 quilts for the next shipment to New Windsor, Maryland in November. The North Carolina Women of the ELCA have a trip to New Windsor, Maryland planned for September 12 – 16, 2018. Those traveling to the Lutheran World Relief warehouse will spend two days helping to package quilts as well as other kits.

Oh yes, the Stewardship Committee is excited about the 2nd Clean Water 5K on September 22, 2018 AND our "Reuse-A-Shoe Project" kicking off this month. We want YOU to check your closets, under beds, in the garage or anywhere old athletic, tennis, track shoes are piling up and bring any color, brand and size of seemingly useless shoes to our collection boxes in the Fellowship Hall.

Nike's Reuse-A-Shoe Program collects worn-out athletic shoes for recycling, regardless of manufacturer. The shoes are transformed into Nike Grind, a material used for athletic and playground surfaces. Susan Moffatt says, "My old athletic shoes are always too worn-out to be used by anyone else and remain in the landfill forever, but come to find out, the shoes can be broken into three parts for recycling: rubber from outsole, foam from the midsole and fabric from the upper." Midsole foam from 2500 pairs of shoes, for example, can make one outdoor basketball court.

Our goal is 2500 worn-out shoes. Let's fill our boxes and spread the word to Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops, neighbors, school groups such as high school cross country teams, businesses, other churches, YMCAs, Runners Groups.
