This Report is for information only. The Minutes for the meeting will be the official record of action taken by the Council. This report shows actions approved at the April 14, 2019 meeting.

- The Minutes from the March 10, 2019 regularly scheduled Council meeting were unanimously approved with the Minutes being revised to state: A motion was made to table the motion to approve the job description until next month, once the Finance committee explores salary options for a Director of Youth and Family Ministries. The motion passed 6-5.
- Pastor requested vacation May 20-26, 2019. A motion was made to approve Pastor's vacation. The motion passed.
- A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion passed.
- Based on the recommendation of the Finance Committee, a motion was made to no longer designate Sunday School offerings collected the fourth Sunday of the month to Community Aid. The motion passed.
- A motion was made to take the previous motion off the table regarding the job description for the Director of Youth and Family Ministries. The motion passed.
- A motion was made to approve the job description for a Director of Youth and
