

Guidelines for Re-Gathering: FLC

1. Worship to be held in the FLC
 - a. Place chairs throughout the FLC in a manner so that a minimum of 6ft separation is maintained. Family units are welcome to sit together
 - b. Chairs shall be cleaned before and after service
 - c. Clean and sanitize bathrooms before service
 - d. Provide cleaning supplies in bathrooms and encourage everyone to clean after each visit
 - e. Need volunteers to direct worshipers to designated areas
 - f. Have appropriate signage recommending social distancing, mask requirements, etc
 - g. Enter the FLC through the front door and exit through the side door

2. Worship Service
 - a. Service will begin at 10:15 am
 - b. Worshipers are required to wear masks at all times
 - i. Worshipers are encouraged to bring their own masks
 - ii. Limited number of masks will be provided
 - iii. Mask must cover nose and mouth
 - c. Service will follow the same format as virtual worship
 - i. Pastor leading, reading lessons, etc.
 - ii. No singing
 - iii. Continue virtual children's sermons
 - iv. Continue to offer virtual worship
 - d. Offering
 - i. No passing of plates
 - ii. Continue to encourage online giving
 - iii. An offering plate will be placed in an area easily accessible for worshipers
 - e. No sharing of the peace
 - f. No celebration of Holy Communion until safe guidelines are established
 - g. No greeting line following worship
 - h. Someone will record attendance and seating arrangement
 - i. Worshipers shall remain in their assigned areas
 - j. Always maintain a minimum of 6ft social distancing, including entering and exiting the FLC
 - k. Water fountain shall be blocked off
 - l. Hand sanitizer shall be available
 - m. Gloves shall be available
 - n. After worshipers are dismissed, they are to exit to their vehicles

3. Necessary items for worship
 - a. Sound system
 - b. Hand sanitizer
 - c. Masks
 - d. Cleaning supplies
 - e. Volunteers for specific duties
